



WHAT WORKS FOR HEALTH SOURCES

Analysts begin with a broad literature search to define each strategy and identify appropriate search terms. Targeted literature searches are then conducted, focusing first on systematic reviews and peer reviewed articles. Searches focus next on selected sources of grey literature and other evidence clearinghouses that assess policy and program effectiveness.
