



Analytic Dataset Codebook:

Supplemental Data Release (September 24, 2025)

The CSV file corresponding to the most recent supplemental data release is available at <https://www.countyhealthrankings.org/explore-health-rankings/rankings-data-documentation> and contains the measure value, numerator, denominator and confidence intervals, where available for measures updated more recently than the 2025 Annual Data Release.

Please note that data are unavailable for Connecticut counties and planning regions in the supplemental data release. Please see the 2025 Annual Data Release for the latest available data for these geographies.

There are six descriptive variables which identify the geographic location and the supplement release date. These variables are:

1. statecode = FIPS State Code
2. countycode = FIPS County Code
3. fipscode = 5-digit FIPS Code
4. state = State abbreviation
5. county = County or State name
6. supplement = supplement release date (yyyymmdd)

Each measure variable name is coded with a unique, numeric measure identifier (measureID). MeasureIDs for measures included in this supplemental data release can be found at the end of this documentation. You will find at least six variables specific to each measure:

1. v(measureID)_rawvalue = measure value
2. v(measureID)_numerator = numerator
3. v(measureID)_denominator = denominator
4. v(measureID)_cilow = lower bound of 95% confidence interval
5. v(measureID)_cihigh = upper bound of 95% confidence interval
6. v(measureID)_flag_CT = 'U' denotes Connecticut counties and planning regions where data are unavailable in this supplemental update

Non-standard measure variables

Health care provider measures (v004, v088, v062, v131): These four measures have a “ratio” variable included. These measures and their corresponding ratio variables are:

- Primary Care Physicians (ratio variable = v004_rawalternatevalue)
- Dentists (ratio variable = v088_rawalternatevalue)
- Mental Health Providers (ratio variable = v062_rawalternatevalue)
- Other Primary Care Providers (ratio variable = v131_rawalternatevalue)

For these measures, the value reported on each county snapshot is a ratio of population:number of providers. This analytic dataset includes both the rate (as the raw value variable), and the *ratio* (as the “rawalternatevalue” variable).
