



## Analytic Dataset Codebook:

### Supplemental Data Release (March 25, 2026)

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This analytic dataset provides updated county-, state-, and national-level data released after the 2025 Annual Data Release. It includes measure values, numerators, denominators, and confidence intervals (where available) and corresponds to the 2025 Health Snapshot updates dated March 25, 2026. #### Data Availability

Data for Connecticut counties and planning regions were not updated in the Health Snapshots for the Supplemental Data Releases. Where available, updated data for Connecticut jurisdictions are provided in this corresponding dataset. These data may be reported for either planning regions or counties, depending on the measure data source. To access the most recent data for Connecticut geographies not included in this dataset, please refer to the 2025 Annual Data Release.

Living Wage (170) data are excluded from the downloadable files. These data are produced by the [Living Wage Institute, Inc.](#) and are available on their [website](#).

#### Identifiers

Six variables identify the geographic unit and the supplement release date:

1. statecode = two-digit FIPS state code
2. countycode = three-digit county code
3. fipscode = five-digit FIPS code
4. state = two-character state abbreviation ("US" for national)
5. county = county or state name ("United States" for national)
6. supplement = supplement release date (yyyymmdd)

#### Standard variables

Each measure variable name is coded with a unique numeric measure identifier (measureID). MeasureIDs for all measures included in the Supplemental Data Release are listed at the end of this document. For each measure (excluding v124), the dataset contains at least five associated variables:

1. v(measureID)\_rawvalue = measure value
2. v(measureID)\_numerator = numerator
3. v(measureID)\_denominator = denominator
4. v(measureID)\_cilow = lower bound of 95% confidence interval
5. v(measureID)\_cihigh = upper bound of 95% confidence interval

#### Non-standard measure variables

**Health care provider measures (v004, v088, v062, v131)** have an additional variable representing the population-to-provider ratio:

- Primary Care Physicians: v004\_rawalternatevalue



- Dentists: v088\_rawalternatevalue
- Mental Health Providers: v062\_rawalternatevalue
- Other Primary Care Providers: v131\_rawalternatevalue

This analytic dataset includes both the rate (stored in the \*\_rawvalue variable) and the ratio (stored in the corresponding \*\_rawalternatevalue variable). Missing \*\_rawalternatevalue values reflect data suppression; a value of 0 indicates zero providers where a value is not suppressed.

**Drinking Water Violations (v124)** is an indicator variable, where a 1 indicates a "Yes", while a 0 indicates a "No".

**Race/ethnicity data** are available for several measures where sub-population sizes are sufficient. Race- and ethnicity-specific values are identified with the following variable suffixes:

- v(measure ID)\_race\_aian for the American Indian & Alaska Native population estimate
- v(measure ID)\_race\_asian for the Asian population estimate
- v(measure ID)\_race\_black for the Black population estimate
- v(measure ID)\_race\_hispanic for the Hispanic population estimate
- v(measure ID)\_race\_nhopi for the Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander population estimate
- v(measure ID)\_race\_tom for the two or more races population estimate
- v(measure ID)\_race\_white for the White population estimate

Where confidence intervals are available for sub-population estimates, the variable names are suffixed using "\_cilow" and "\_cihigh" extensions to denote the upper and lower limits of the confidence interval. For example, the confidence interval limits for the American Indian & Alaska Native estimate of Years of Potential Life Lost values are stored in v001\_race\_aian\_cilow and v001\_race\_aian\_cihigh.

Race and ethnicity group definitions and suppression criteria vary by measure and data source. **Suppressed or unreliable data** are flagged for Premature Death (v001) and Low Birth Weight (v037) measures. These variables are labeled v(measure ID) flag. A value of 1 indicates the relative standard error is greater than 20% and the estimate may be unreliable. A value of 2 indicates that the data were suppressed. Premature Death (v001) data are suppressed for geographies with a population less than 100,000 and fewer than 20 death events over the three-year period; and for Low Birth Weight (v037) for geographies with fewer than 10 LBW birth events in the seven-year period. Race/ethnicity variables may also be flagged as suppressed or unreliable. These variables are suffixed using "\_flag2" extensions.
