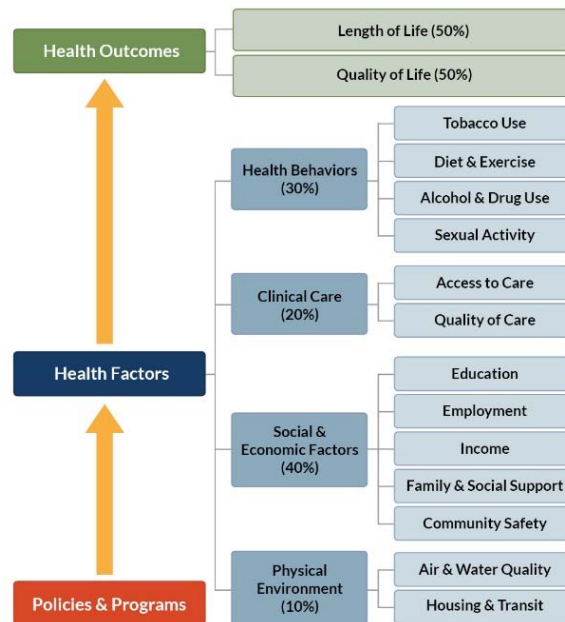
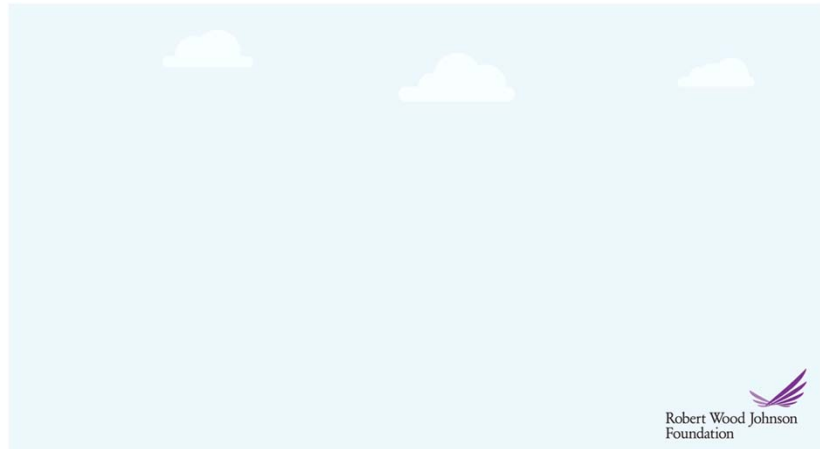

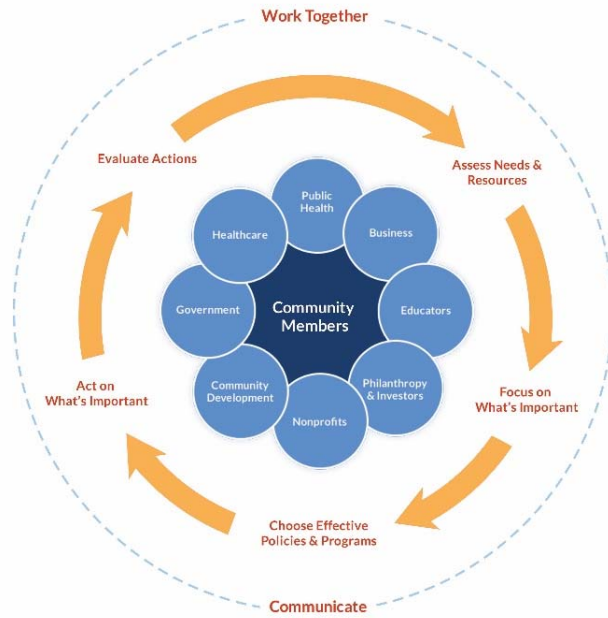

GETTING STARTED WITH BUILDING RESIDENT ENGAGEMENT IN THE DELTA REGION

Action Learning Cohort Application

County Health Rankings & Roadmaps (CHRR) is connecting communities from across the Delta Region to learn together about their experiences and identify strategies to build resident engagement. We know that getting started with building resident engagement can be hard, yet important and valuable work. As an organization committed to building a culture of health, we hope to support you in that work through a Delta Region action learning cohort.

Cohort Purpose

The action learning cohort will create opportunities to learn together and from one another about challenges communities across the Delta Region are experiencing and successful or promising strategies they are using to build resident engagement. The cohort is also intended to help build relationships and encourage collaboration among communities and groups in the region.

The learning cohort will meet virtually, using web-based video conferencing and facilitated discussions, with one in-person meeting in the region (travel funds will be provided for the convening). Action Learning Coaches from CHRR will guide you in the learnings, and together, your team will consider how to apply your learning in your home community.
