She is an organizer with the Boston-based DeeperThanWater Coalition and a co-author of the American Public Health Association policy statements on law enforcement violence and carceral systems. She has a Master of Divinity from Harvard Divinity School and a Doctor of Science in social and behavioral science from Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health.

Mark Rice serves as the Wisconsin Transformational Justice Campaign Coordinator at <u>WISDOM</u>. Much of his work over the last 10 years has focused on overhauling the carceral system and building the power of organizations led by people who have been impacted by this system. Mark also serves as a member of three national steering committees that aim to fundamentally transform the criminal legal system.

Mark earned master's degrees in urban studies and nonprofit management and leadership from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. In 2016, he received the Distinguished Leadership
