Healthy People, Healthy Communities

Phase 1:

Analysis of 150+ health indicators on NJHC database; stakeholder input on needs

Phase 2:

Initial prioritization; from ~150 issues per county to ~12 issues per county

Phase 6:

Continuous evaluation that informs implementation and data collection



Phase 3:

"Digging deeper" to uncover root causes and affected populations/geographies

Phase 5:

Implementation of collective county-wide plans via NJHC partner organizations

Phase 4:

Final prioritization (5 issues per county) and action planning via issue workgroups



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Evaluation at Multiple Levels



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PROVIDE TAILORED INFORMATION TO TARGETED GROUPS (NON-PROFESSIONALS)

Strategies included in this category are those that aim to provide tailored information to targeted groups (e.g., providing health resources in multiple languages to residents of specific geographies).

HOW MUCH DID WE DO?
